Aging

- **Grape type:** Pinot Noir
- **Region:** Brda - Slovenia
- **Vineyards:** Breg Cru (SLO)
- **Vineyards age:** 18 - 41 years
- **Vineyards altitude:** 150 - 250 metres above sea level
- **Vineyards exposure:** east (Breg)
- **Soil type:** marl, slate and sandstone
- **Harvest:** hand-harvested, bunches carefully selected - in the middle of September
- **Vinification:** fermentation in contact with skins of berries (maceration) for 14 days in 3,000 litre conical oak barrel (tino); without selected yeasts. Softly pressed with pneumatic pressure.
- **Maturation:** 27 months in 225 litre French oak barrels (barrique), up to 30 % new barrels.
- **Maturation in bottle:** at least one year
- **Alcohol:** 13,5 % vol
- **Total acidity:** 5,4 g/l
- **Bottle:** 0,75 l, 1,5 l
- **Bottling:** 2.000 bottles 0,75 l, 213 bottles 1,5 l in January 2015, without cleaning and filtration
- **Serving temperature:** 16 - 18 °C
