



PINOT GRIGIO Brda Classic 2025

Grape type: Pinot Grigio

Region: Collio – Italy, Brda – Slovenia

Vineyards: Zegla, Rusic / Italy; Plešivo / Slovenia

Vineyards age: 19 - 39 years

Vineyards' altitude: 120 - 250 meters above sea level

Vineyards' exposure: south-east

Viticulture: Organic / Biodynamic

Soil type: marl, clay, limestone

Harvest: hand-harvested in the first half of September

Vinification: Up to 24 hours of maceration, fermentation starts spontaneously with the grapes' natural yeasts in stainless steel tanks.

Maturation: 6 months on the yeasts in stainless steel tanks

Alcohol: 13,0 % vol **Total acidity:** 4,69 g / l

Residual sugar: Dry **Bottle:** 0,75 l

Aging potential: The maturation of a classical Pinot Grigio may develop fantastically up to ten years.

Wine description: There's just a touch of copper in the colour from the pink skins of the grape variety. It entices with aromas of sweet spices, red apple, and fresh-cut pear. The palate follows through, building on notes of spiced pear and golden plum, with a lightly mineral texture and gentle acidity. This is an elegant Pinot Grigio with so much more character than most.

Food matching ideas: Due to its elegant, complex structure, we recommend pairing it with various dishes—from cold fish starters to spring-summer pasta. It is excellent with seafood dishes and not too spicy Asian, Thai, and modern Japanese cuisine.

Serving temperature: 11 - 12 °C
